PfA Subgroup

The PfA Subgroup met on Thursday, 28 May 2020 and ended the meeting with the following Key points to share:

- The subgroup are reviewing a PfA Annual Review Checklist that has been designed around the four PfA key areas which are used to think about planning for an adult life in the community
- A housing themed meeting will be taking place in June with the PfA Subgroup to begin the process of understanding the current housing offer available
- We will be looking to schedule another meeting with the parent carer reference group, where documents provided by the Education Welfare Service to young people and their families when home educating will be reviewed and discussed
